She had a steep, weathered and unstable ramp she had to use when going to doctor appointments. When Revitalize T-Town staff first visited her home, she said, "I have a terrible fear of going down that ramp."

Revitalize T-Town built a new ramp for Ms. Bessie. When she saw their completed work, she said, "I love it. I do. I do. I do!"

Ms. Bessie was thrilled that she would be able to safely get outside to attend her grandson's wedding at the end of October. "My old ramp was an accident waiting to happen. I was so fearful. Now I can go outside! This is such a blessing." Ms. Bessie baked pound cake for the volunteers to say thank you. She said, "My mother told me to never let someone be nicer to you than you are to them. I have remembered that. There is no reason to not be generous!"

# Program Sponsorship: Year-Round

Revitalize T-Town offers home repairs through four focus areas. Sponsorships supporting our home repair program are available from \$1,000 - \$100,000.

- Roofs: Roof repair and replacement.
- Safe at Home: Includes home modification repairs such as wheelchair ramps, grab bars, ADA compliant faucets, handheld showers, shower seats, raised toilets, fire safety and other repairs that ensure the safety of the homeowner.
- Energy Efficiency: Energy efficiency repairs help provide a weatherproof home and decrease energy bills for the low-income families we serve. These repairs can include attic insulation, replacing broken windows, sealing cracks around doors and windows, installing compact fluorescent (CFL) light bulbs, installing water conserving fixtures and any other repairs that are considered energy efficient on a case-by-case basis for the individual homeowner.
- R.O.O.T. (Repairs Offered Other Times): R.O.O.T. repairs include all other repair needs not offered as part of the other three focus areas and can include electrical, plumbing, painting and any other repairs that are considered necessary to make the home safe, secure and weatherproof or improve the neighborhood.
